Tuition:

*Attending **any one week:** \$100.00 (\$50.00 deposit required, cancellation refund: \$25.00)

*Attending **any two weeks:** \$90.00 per week (\$50.00 deposit per week required, cancellation refund: \$22.00 per cancelled week)

*Attending **any three weeks:** \$80.00 per week (\$50.00 deposit per week required, cancellation refund: \$20.00 per cancelled week)

*Attending **any four or five weeks:** \$75.00 per week (\$50.00 deposit required, cancellation refund: \$15.00 per cancelled week)

***Full tuition must be received one week prior to the week of your student's attendance.

Snack Bar Available: Kindergarten - Eighth grade students will have a recess/break at 9:30 - 9:50. A snack bar will be open with items ranging in price from 25 cents to \$1.00. Students are welcome to bring snacks from home.

Before and after school care is available from 7:00 a.m. until 8:15 a.m. when classes begin, and from 12:15 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. for students who are 4 years, 9 months and older who are attending summer school. Day care for younger students, 12:15 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. may be arranged through the Preschool. Day care fees are \$15.00 per child, per day.

Cost for daycare on weeks no summer school is held is \$20.00 per child, per day.
